Food Pantry - Food poverty exists in Baldwin City. The food pantry is addressing an increasing need with each passing week. We have people visiting the pantry who do not have homes. Summer presents additional challenges for families with children not in school and missing the meals available in that setting. Food items in need include: protein sources (meat, nuts, beans and rice, peanut butter), canned fruits, boxed meals, canned spaghetti/ravioli, cereal and baby food. Thank you for the continuing support - allowing the pantry to be a vessel in which another may see the hands, eyes and heart of a loving God.
